## **Eligibility**

- Verify the eligibility conditions before submitting the application :
- Hold a PhD degree within the past five years;
- Be recommended by a UdeM research supervisor and the director of the academic unit (Faculty, School, Department, etc.):
- Hold a scholarship or be paid by the supervisor or the academic unit.

#### **Admission**

- · Complete the online admission application and choose the appropriate study program
- Provide the required documents:
  - Identity documents (certified copy or original)
- Work Permit (for foreign fellows) (www.cic.gc.ca)
- PhD diploma or achievement certificate (certified copy or original)
- Curriculum Vitae
- The acceptance form signed by the supervisor and the chair of the unit
- Supervisor's invitation letter

#### Renewal

- Verify the eligibility conditions before submitting the application
- Renew your work permit (if applicable)
- Apply through your student center: form "CHE Prolongation stage"
